Dry years in California and the Colorado River Basin have strained water supplies. Pending court action to save the Delta smelt could take another chunk of water needed by the state. What does all this mean to farmers, ranchers, and nurserymen in San Diego County? It means 2008 could be a record low year for water supplies with mandatory cuts for growers on the horizon. Even growers on "firm" water supplies could be facing cuts. Know what the water picture looks like and be prepared.
